Students who wish to apply for this scholarship must submit the Scholarship Application along with the following items:

- An unofficial high school transcript
- A Typed Essay
 - A. Please explain why you believe you deserve this scholarship and how it will help you achieve your future career goals.
 - B. Must be at least 1000 words in length
- Music CD or Performance DVD
 - A. On a separate piece of paper, please specify the following:
 1. Whether or not the work is an original composition
 2. The title of the work and instrument(s) used (if applicable)
- Resume of Performances

APPLICATIONS DUE APRIL 30, 2012

This is a one time, merit based scholarship in the amount of \$5,000 that will be given directly to the student's chosen college or university upon acceptance. Selection is based on artistic achievement, scholastic achievement, school and community participation, and leadership. Recipients will be chosen by a panel of judges comprised of distinguished art professionals.
