GALLERY HONORS STUDENT ARTISTS

Kenny Goss, co-founder of the Goss-Michael Foundation and his partner, musician George Michael, recently announced the winners of the 2010 "Ready. Set. Go! Student Art Contest," sponsored by the Goss-Michael Foundation. The Best in Show prize for the student art contest, a \$750 US Savings Bond, went to Newman Smith High School student Esteban Jaramillo. In addition, Jaramillo's winning submission will become part of The Goss-Michael Collection, displayed at the Foundation alongside the work of prominent British contemporary artists. Blake Rutledge, a Trinity Valley School student won Best in Drawing; Newman Smith High School student Sophia Espinosa received the prize for Best in Photography; and Trinity Valley School student Will Shea won Best in Painting. Each of these three award winners received a \$500 US Savings Bond.
